

Newspaper Club Registration (Grades 4-8)

The expectation is that all students and parents understand the purpose for this activity to help ensure it is productive for all students. This is not time for socializing but time for completing work with the assistance of a teacher. Cooperation from students is key to making this work. Parental support of the guidelines is greatly appreciated and necessary for students to participate.

Newspaper Club will be sponsored and supervised by Mrs. DeSantos and Mr. Deegan. The purpose of Newspaper Club is to provide students in Grades 4-8 an opportunity to share the good news of our school by producing relevant articles for our school newsletters and newspapers. Both teachers and students have the responsibility to ensure the Newspaper Club is a place conducive to producing quality school newsletters and newspapers.

Student Responsibilities:

- Come prepared. Bring a snack, all books, and materials.
- Work independently.
- Ask for help when needed.
- Respect others and their belongings.
- Use computers for academic purposes only.
- Manage time well.
- Keep cell phones in backpacks on silent or off. School policy applies to after school activities.
- Communicate with the teacher if there is a need to leave Newspaper Club.

Teacher Responsibilities:

- Provide a safe, productive learning environment for each student.
- Provide guidance to students seeking help.
- Supervise all students as they move from the study hall to the reception area for dismissal.
- Bring all students not picked up on time to the main office.

Parent Responsibilities:

- Review, sign and return registration contract with your student. All students must be registered to participate.
- Pick up student by the 4 pm dismissal time.
